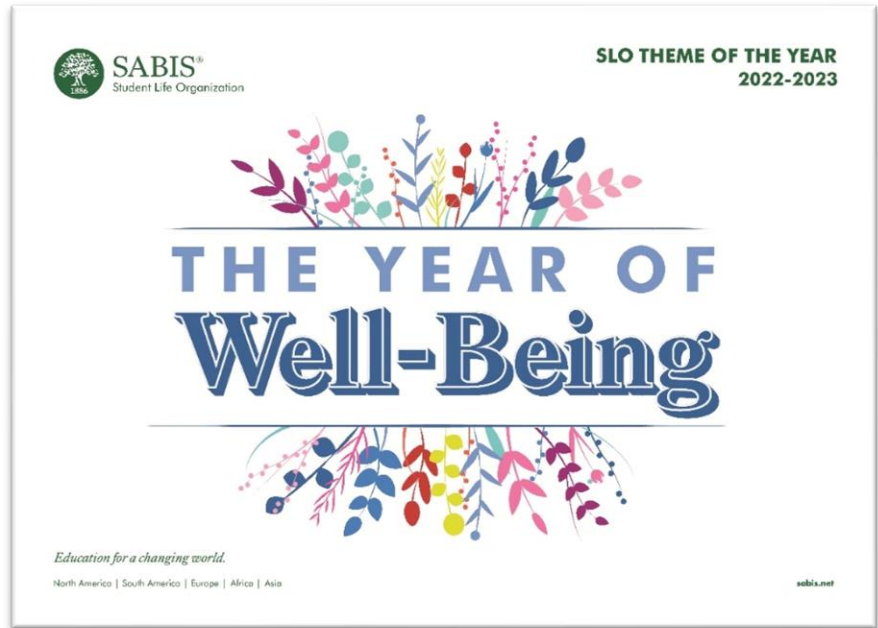
### SLO Theme of the Year is Revealed

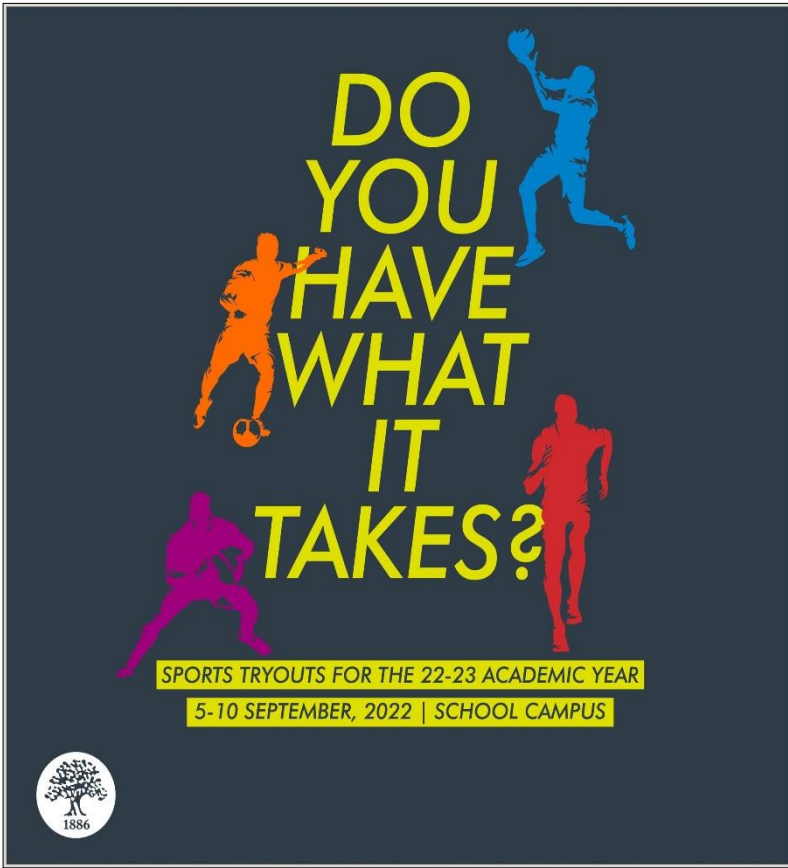
## ACADEMIC INSIGHTS

Team building activities, fun and friendly competitions, Lower School activities, and sports games have seen the light again in their full form after two years of interruption and modification due to the pandemic.

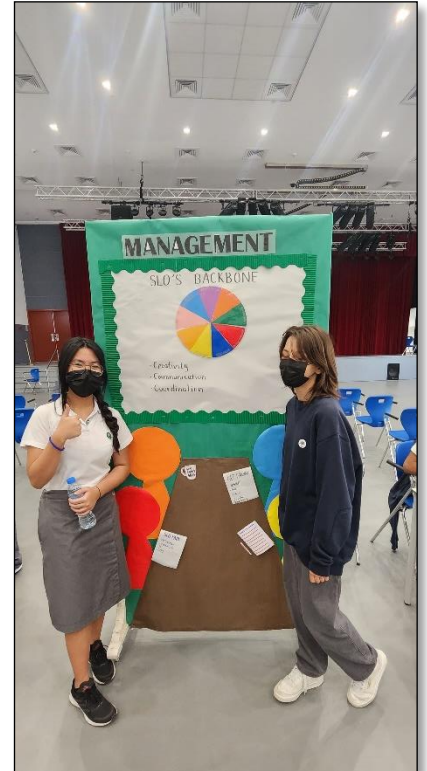
